It is sound enough for short term storage and has been offered to the Walpole Historical Society. A meeting should be arranged between both groups and Dale will make contact with Christie Winmill.

On Monday, July 22, 2019, John Sheldon and Linda Edkins met with Christie Winmill and Thomas Spiltoir of the WHS at the Drewsville Cemetery. It was a rainy day and found the little barn to be dry inside, a good sign for storing the hearse. Christie and Thomas were interested in the space and would be in contact regarding getting the hearse moved in
