WATER:

Patrick discussed the video meeting he and Cheryl had with W&S and funding partners on June 3rd. The UV system is scheduled to arrive from Trojan on Wednesday. Work will commence the end of June.

There is a disagreement about retainage funds between DES and USDA. The end result is that USDA will hold retainage from their funds, but DES will send full amount and Village will hold the retainage.

Randy Suozzo from DES will do a monthly AIS inspection.

Trojan will deliver a 90 gallon Solution Tank rather than the original 125 gallon tank. Village needs to purchase a plastic pallet and hand jack in order to move the tank around. Motion was made by Com Colburn, seconded by Com Aumand to allow Com Kiniry to purchase the pallet and jack for up to \$500. Motion carried.
