FIRE:

3 members are enrolled in an EMT class and are being asked to obtain personal insurance for ride along. Chief thinks they should be covered under the Fire Station insurance. Becca will contact Primex in the morning to confirm. The personal insurance will cost \$120 total.

WATER:

Issues with Consolidated have been occurring since Friday during the storm. This has caused alarms to bounce from high to low due to the lines not functioning correctly. Bob called Consolidated Sunday and was given a ticket number. They did not return his call. Pat called Monday and they confirmed someone would be out by Wednesday.

Booster Pump was certified by Franklin Pump System.

Results from samples came in, Sodium Permanganate levels need to be adjusted. Chlorine needs to be adjusted slightly but levels are acceptable.

Water bills are coming in slowly.

Violation notices will go out within the next two weeks, tentatively on September 30th.

Pat called Escor. They will be calling the office to schedule an appointment.

A resident from Pearl Street asked about paving, Pat informed them that we have not heard any more information.
