Commissioners Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Com. O'Brien

**FIRE:**

Chief discussed information he had received about payroll dates from other departments. This was in reference to DOL warnings about our pay schedules. Joint loss committee plans were discussed and Ms. Mayberry suggested that perhaps North Walpole could join the Walpole committee rather than having to form their own. Clerk will check with DOL to determine if this is possible.

Chief noted that he is working on his 2018 budget proposal.

**WATER:**

Latest water test results for 1,4-Dioxane came back from the State at >0.16. Mr. Kiniry noted that he had replaced an in-line filter at a residence on Willow St.

**MISC:**

Town has advised that the sidewalk plow has been damaged by chunks of granite and/or concrete on the sidewalk on Church Street between Brady and Russell. Damage has resulted in over \$1400 in repairs.

Commissioners believe the pieces are caused by the State Plows breaking pieces of curbing and sidewalks off during plowing runs.

Com Kiniry complained that Maple Street is not being plowed during snow storms partly due to an illegally parked vehicle.

Ms. Mayberry advised that she will be contacting Brendon and Jeff to get updates on what is happening with the grant requests for updating the water

treatment building. Commissioners need to complete a questionnaire and sign paperwork to proceed. Also, Water Operator needs to get written quotes for replacing some old water lines and using the money in Trust Funds.




Meeting adjourned at 8:45 pm.
