Commissioners Meeting called to order at 7:07 pm by Com. O'Brien

Minutes of January 09, 2018 meeting approved as written.

Note: There was no Commissioner's meeting January 16, 2018 due to illness.

✓ Note: Current Village Treasurer, Kathleen Foster resigned the position effective January 17, 2018, leaving the Village without a Treasurer.

✓ Kaitlynn Bashaw was attending tonight's meeting to inquire about the Treasurer's position and apply for the position. After briefly explaining the duties, Com Walker made the motion to appoint Kaitlynn Bashaw as Village Treasurer until Village Meeting in April 2018 at a rate of pay of \$12.50 per hour. Motion Seconded by Com Kiniry. All three Commissioners voted in favor.

FIRE:

Chief presented invoices totaling \$225.66 which the Commissioners approved. Chief attended a FEMA conducted Hazard Mitigation in Walpole recently. The program covered Environmental Hazards. Part of the discussion reviewed hazards and/or possible hazards within the Village of North Walpole.

Chief noted that the new truck committee met with a representative of a truck manufacturer and discussed various aspects of a new truck. Rough estimate of the cost of the vehicle being looked at is \$535,000.

Chief Crawford will attend a Homeland Security Meeting at the North Walpole School on Wednesday, January 24, 2018.

WATER:

Bob McGuirk has been in contact with D & N Tanks of Wakefield, MA regarding required tank inspections. To have both tanks done will cost \$4,000. The inspections will be done during the summer of 2018.

Hodgkins & Sons has provided estimates for water pipe replacements as well as valves. This information is needed in order to apply for a grant to upgrade the water treatment facility.


MISC:



Motion by Com Walker and seconded by Com Kiniry at 8:58 pm to adjourn the meeting.
