Cheryl will do follow ups with Jeff McClure as to the next steps and to ascertain that Jeff is officially under contract with the Village.

MISC:


Com O'Brien noted and reported that there was a large pot hole on Killeen Street and thanked the Highway Department for their prompt response in filling it in.




Letter to TD bank naming the new Treasurer and authorizing the Treasurer and Commissioners to sign checks and have access to the bank account was approved.


Motion by Com Walker and Seconded by Com Kiniry for Meeting to adjourn at 8:07 pm.
