FIRE:

Chief presented invoice from LaValley's for new front door of \$434.72, previously approved by the Commissioners.

Chief attended the second Hazard Mitigation session in Walpole today and presented books from FEMA to be placed in the Commissioner's Office and in the North Walpole Library.

Chief is investigating to determine if the outside siren on the Fire Station is operable and can be repaired and brought up to standard by today's codes.

WATER:

Bob found some limbs on wires going to the East Street reservoirs. He will contact the utility company or attempt to remove them when hill conditions get better.

Water has flooded the inside of the burned house on East Street. Water has been shut off inside the house but Bob unable to shut off outside due to damaged gate valve. The gate valve will need to be replaced.


MISC:

There is concern about a proposed Vibrator which the DOT may want to locate at 118 Church Street for shifting sand during the road construction. Further investigation is being done.

Commissioners discussed a proposed petition article from a resident for the Warrant at Village Meeting. The resident did not have the required number of names of registered Village Voters; the article was seeking money to improve Town property and was nearing the deadline for presentation to the Commissioners. Any action was tabled until next meetings.


