Chief advised that the Department has been doing some research and have decided to re-establish an Explorer Troop.

WATER:

Bob noted that water test samples will be taken next week.

Bob updated Commissioners on Water Bill collections and progress on fixing connection pipe/shut off on East Street

Bob noted that he will be adding a blow-off Hydrant on the end of Willow Street.

May 19 – Hydrant Flushing within the Village starting approximately 9:00 am.

MISC:

Darlene Pecor appeared stating concerns about the increase in the sewer bond charge. She was particularly concerned about being double charged for her property at 3 and 5 East Street. She noted that on the Tax Files it is one property but has two water connections/meters. Therefore the Town is charging her \$180 Sewer Bond and she feel that whereas it is listed as one property tax-wise she should only be charge for one or \$90. Commissioners advised her to attend the Select Board Meeting on May 3 as this is a Town issue and not a Village issue.
