Bob attended GSRW Field Day in Sunapee today, attended a couple of seminars and obtained some valuable information.

Bob is still trying to obtain valve parts for inside the water treatment building.

Bob noted that the road to the Reservoir has been seriously wash out and needs to be repaired. He will contact Hodgkins and arrange to have it fixed along with the pipe on East Street.

**MISC:**

Received information from DES concerning the grant/loan for the upgrading of the treatment building. Cheryl Mayberry will attend Commissioners meeting on September 18 to discuss and explain.

Bill Gallagher received an estimate from E E Houghton for installing lights at the Village/Town Park on Main Street. The Estimate was about \$3,300. Com O'Brien

suggested that the Committee submit a requested budget to the Town Recreation Department for inclusion in their 2018 budget..
