**FIRE:**

Chief presented invoices totaling \$ 1,086.93 which were approved by the Commissioners. Chief did a Fire Inspection of the Warming Shelter and they passed the inspection. Shelter scheduled to open on Thursday, November 15, 2018. Fire Department will hold their annual family Christmas party on December 15. Commissioners are invited.

**WATER:**

Received notice from DES that they have added three contaminants to the SOC tests. They are Dibomochloropropane (DBCP); Ethylene dibromide (EDB); Diquat. Comm. O'Brien signed a work order to Aquastore to update our CP System, remove depleted anodes and install three magnesium anodes. Complaints of "pink" water was addressed last week. The cause was an over ingestion of potassium permanganate, which is not harmful if drank. Excessive use of water at 12 Spruce Street was discussed. Cause was due to a leaking water heater. No action was taken.

**MISC:**

Reviewed Primex Insurance Coverages, everything is okay as noted. Reviewed Asset Management Grant from DES.

Noted that 37 Center Street has been purchased by Dussalt Property Management.

Approved check from Trustee of Trust Funds and mailed to Weston and Sampson for services performed through September 28, 2018.

**CHERYL MAYBERRY:**

Ms. Mayberry was in to review the USDA loan application and explain the next steps needed. A public hearing is required, within 10 days after a notice is posted in the newspaper. There were questions that needed to be answered, such as money in all bank accounts. These were answered. Ms. Mayberry will contact Jeff McClure and schedule a date for the public hearing and then a notice will be placed in the newspaper.
