Commissioners Meeting called to order at 7:08 pm by Com. O'Brien

Minutes of November 13, 2018 meeting were accepted as written...

FIRE:

Chief presented invoices totaling \$419.34 which were approved by the Commissioners. Chief discussed recent meeting with Matt Yeatman, Sales Rep for Fire engine company... The new vehicle that the Fire Department Committee is looking at would cost a total of \$516,700. Chief explained various payment options. He will schedule a meeting with Mr. Yeatman to meet with the Commissioners and explore options in detail.

WATER:

Bob will schedule a date for Aquastore to do maintenance work of the water tank on Mountain View and put in new anodes. This will require the draining of the tank, which will reduce water pressure to many residents on the hill and leave a few without water during the process. When a definite date is scheduled, Bob will notify each household affected in writing. Due to some reduced efficiency, Bob will investigate replacing the Green Sand in the Treatment Building. He will also follow up on getting estimates for coating the East Street reservoir roofs. Recent water tests were taken, including VOC's, SOC's and Nitrate and all results were below the States requirements.

Motion by Com O'Brien, Seconded by Com Kiniry to adjourn the meeting at 8:35 pm. Two in favor.


