The Auditors will be at the office on Wednesday, February 20, 2019 to audit the Village accounts.


Warrant articles were reviewed and some changes were made, to be reviewed again at next meeting.


Motion by Com Kiniry, Seconded by Com Colburn to adjourn the meeting at 8:35 pm.
