Commissioners Meeting called to order at 7:07 pm by Com. O'Brien

Com. Kiniry was not in attendance.

FIRE:

Chief presented paperwork showing promotion and pay increase for Paul Frederic to \$11.50hr and yearly salary of \$300 effective February 01, 2019.

Chief presented an invoice for \$400, plus February's payroll of \$3,064.65. Both items approved by the Commissioners.

Chief has a quote for restoring the outside siren from Amer of \$ 2,564.13. Once restored this will sound for fire calls up to 9:00 pm and for any situations considered as a Village wide disaster.

WATER:

Bob took a variety of water samples for State testing and sent them today.

Bob will contact the new owners of 4 Birch Street and turn their water back on to the property.

MISC:

Ms Mayberry continues to work on supplying information to the USDA in order to receive the grant money which was filed for. She was looking for an estimate to recoat the reservoir roofs, which the Village has been unable to obtain from suppliers.

Ms Mayberry further noted that she was contacted by DES and they would like to meet with the Commissioners to discuss the Village water system. Commissioners proposed the date of April 2nd, which Ms. Mayberry will relay to the DES.

Maple Street Project was discussed and it was decided that the Village will need to delay the replacement of pipes until 2020. Ms Mayberry will relay this to Mr. Rau, so the Town can reschedule the repaving project until after the pipes are replaced.

It was decided that the previously planned replace of pipes in a section of Mountain View will be done this summer.

Motion by Com O'Brien, Seconded by Com Colburn to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 pm. Two in favor.
