**WATER SHUT OFF DATE IS MARCH 23<sup>rd</sup> FOR RESIDENTS OF UNPAID WATER INVOICES.**


**MISC:**

Village books are now available at 5 Star, Food Discount, the NW Library and the Commissioner's office.




Motion by Com Kiniry, Seconded by Com Colburn to adjourn the meeting at 8:05 pm. Three in favor.
