Commissioner's Meeting called to order at 7:04 pm, January 05, 2021.

Minutes of January 05, 2021 .approved by Motion from Com Aumand, seconded by Com. Colburn. Three in favor.

Zoom Meeting with Weston & Sampson started at 7:02 pm.  
This was a review of the Design proposal and was a question and answer session.  
Bob asked about the water heater in the WTB, which currently is not working.  
Cheryl noted that the report had a couple of typos, one being the amount of money, which should read \$700,000.  
Treating the water with Potassium Permanganate and Chlorine was reviewed. Samuel noted that only Potassium Permanganate would be needed and no Chlorine.  
GAC was reviewed.  
Patrick noted that during the testing period there were several of brown water and staining from residents. Samuel suggested increasing the Pot. Perm. Slightly for a couple of days and if it doesn't clear up, to increase a little more.  
It was decided that there should be a Zoom meeting at least once a month.  
Zoom meeting ended at 7:38 pm

Regular meeting resumed at 7:39 pm.

**FIRE:**

Chief turned in a pay increase for Randy Rumrill.  
Discussed a request from Dan's Max Saver, Charlestown for payment of \$57.90 for a purchase made back on April 2, 2020. After checking it was decided that the individual who picked up the order and was reimbursed for the amount of purchase, had not actually paid Dan's Max Saver. A check has been cut for Dan's Max Saver. Chief Crawford will discuss with the individual involved.  
Over the weekend the Fire Department stripped the equipment/gear from the two vehicles being replaced and mapped out how to load the new truck.  
Still waiting to hear on a tentative delivery date of the new vehicle.  
Chief is getting three quotes for new tires for Engine#2.  
Chief has finalized the Department's 2021 budget at \$102,000.

Chief discussed driver certifications. Several members are qualified drivers, except for the pumping portion.

**WATER:**

Bob has been notified that the Sewer Pump Station continues to have problems. Patrick noted that the pumps were about 35 years old and that Ms. Mayberry advised that they were looking into a grant to replace them.

Bob will switch to Well#508 and adjust the potassium permanganate.

**MISC:**

Com Kiniry thanked the NW Fire Department for helping to distribute the Water Violation notices on Sunday.

Mrs. Brady called about the street light at the corner of Brady and Birch being out. With the recent string of burglaries, she would like it replaced. Com Kiniry will contact the Town.

Email from VHB looking for information on 1,4-Dioxane and Trojan UV Systems. Patrick will forward the Email to Weston & Sampson.

Request from Fall Mountain Regional School regarding continuation of the Spirit of North Walpole Community Scholarship. Reply will be sent.

Commissioners received a Certified Letter from Len-Tex Corporation requesting copies of Commissioners Meeting Minutes since November 01, 2020 and any Zoning Permits issued to Greg Gay since September 1, 2020. Material will be gathered and mailed.
