Companies will not guarantee that the carbon process will remove the 1,4 Dioxane. It looks as if a hazardous removal company will have to be contracted to pump the wells and remove to a hazardous disposal site.**

**Patrick did two more Pre-Bid walk-throughs of the WTB. They had questions for Ethan about the pavement replacement and makeup of the polishing filters.**
