WATER/SEWER CONNECTION APPLICATION

1. Town of Walpole Water-Sewer Department application must be completed and returned to the Selectboard Office with payment of the hookup fees
2. Sewer Hookup Fees: A \$750.00 hookup fee plus costs will be charged each new hookup. A \$75.00 inspection fee will be charged if the Walpole Water & Sewer Department does not implement the hookup. These fees are due when submitting the application.
3. Water Hookup Fees: A \$750.00 hookup fee plus costs will be charged each new hookup. A \$75.00 inspection fee will be charged if the Walpole Water & Sewer Department does not implement the hookup. These fees are due when submitting the application.
4. Plumbing must be the responsibility of a certified plumber. Their name and license number must be given.

All sewer connections shall conform to the Walpole Sewer Ordinance and all other laws and regulations applying to said connection, all water service connections shall conform to the Walpole Water Ordinance and International Plumbing Code, 2009 version, as well as other laws and regulations applying to said connection.

Cost of connection shall be \$750.00 per service due upon submittal of this application.

All costs associated with the actual connection shall be invoiced by the Town of Walpole and is the responsibility of the undersigned. The Town of Walpole will install service connections to the edge of the Towns right of way; the undersigned is responsible for all work performed on private property. All installations are to be inspected by the Water & Sewer department, which reserves the right to deny service if inspection fails.
